**Text:** Ephesians 1:17-23  
Ephesians 3:14-21  
Colossians 1:9-14

**INTRODUCTION:** Since the Bible is inspired by God (2 Timothy 3:16) and the Apostle Paul wrote by inspiration (2 Peter 1:20,21) of the Holy Ghost, and God is no respecter of persons (Acts 10:34), these prayers that are penned are for us as well as to those whom the epistles were written.
